

The GHCC Council of Elders is pleased to announce that we will be reopening for in person worship service beginning on Sunday, June 7th. In order to be compliant with the requirements of the City and County of Los Angeles and support our efforts to provide a safe worship opportunity for all attending, there will be several changes to how we run and conduct our activities, so we wanted to communicate these to you for your awareness.

1. People identified by the CDC as higher risk for Covid-19 or those who are feeling sick on Sunday morning, should remain home and watch the service via live stream which we plan on continuing to produce for at least the next few weeks.
2. Bring your own writing utensil as we will no longer have any available.
3. No food or drink will be allowed inside the building. No refreshment time will be held prior to our service.
4. When you arrive in the parking lot, you will notice that every other space has been blocked off to help maintain social distancing. Do NOT move any of these cones. If the Main North Parking Lot is full, please utilize the South Parking Lot or Index Street for additional parking. Please be careful when traveling around the building into and out of the South Parking Lot.
5. We will be having our Outdoor Prayer Time in the park area from 9:30 - 10:15am. We will have chairs set up and observe social distancing and face mask requirements. We encourage you to come and enjoy this special time together.
6. We will NOT be holding Adult Sunday School, Youth Group, Nursery or King's Kids activities for the first few weeks. We plan on slowly transitioning back to our normal schedule of activities and more communication will occur as these get approved for reopening.
7. Everyone over the age of 2 is required to wear a face mask covering their nose and mouth at all times while on the GHCC property.
8. We will be using ONLY the East doors off of the patio for entrance into the Worship Center. The West doors will be for Exit only purposes. Do NOT open these doors to allow others to enter. There will be new signage on the doors.

9. We will be opening the doors into the Worship Center at 10:20am. If you arrive before that time, as you come into the patio area, look for the marks on the ground to help maintain social distancing while waiting for entry into the building.
10. There will be Welcome Team members at each entrance door where each person entering will be asked to verify they are not experiencing any symptoms of Covid-19, have their temperature checked using a touchless forehead device and verified to be wearing a face mask in order to be allowed entry into the building.
11. We are under a temporary maximum occupancy capacity limitation per LA City and County requirements, so it is possible that all available seats may be occupied before everyone who wants to attend can be seated. We encourage you to arrive no later than 10:20am to help avoid being turned away once we reach capacity.
12. During our offering time, we will not be passing the Offering Pouches but will have a wooden Offering Box located on the stage up front to deposit your offering before service, during offering time or after service. Offering envelopes will be available at the entrance or next to the offering box. They are no longer located in the backs of the chairs.
13. Hand sanitizer will be available at entrances and bathrooms.
14. Touchless soap dispensers have been installed in bathrooms.

We appreciate your support of these steps and procedures which are intended to help us create an environment where we can all feel comfortable and appreciate the opportunity to come together again to worship our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
